
THE PABST FARMS



Returning Home

This summer we had the arrival of several exciting items original to the Pabst Mansion donated by a direct descendant of Elsbeth Pabst. The objects include the original candlesticks and clock that were once placed on the dining room mantle and Mrs. Pabst's mahogany writing desk from her upstairs sitting room. All of these items can be seen in our original 1897 photographs of the mansion's interior. We are thrilled with the donation of these items, as they bring a tangible connection to objects chosen and utilized by Mrs. Pabst.





Frederick Pabst on Horseback



Yet another internet auction produces a rare find. This photo shows Frederick Pabst on horseback with August Uihlein standing just behind. Uihlein was the Secretary and largest share holder of the Schlitz Brewing Company. The photo was taken in December 1895 while Milwaukee businessmen were visiting the Delta Cooperage Company in Philip, Mississippi.

This is the only known photograph of Captain Pabst seated on a horse. A wonderful addition to the Pabst Mansion's archives.

portrait of **Elsbeth Pabst**

A well-known portrait painter, Caesar Philipp created this life-size portrait of Captain and Mrs. Pabst's eldest grandchild Elsbeth in 1894, when she was three years old. The only child to grow up in the Pabst Mansion, Elsbeth's portrait hung in her bedroom above the fireplace mantle. When the Pabst Mansion was sold in 1908, it was among the contents divided among the Pabst children.

The portrait was donated back to the Pabst Mansion in 2010, by three of Elsbeth's grandchildren: Douglas Parmentier Jr., Martha Parmentier Van Aman, and Steve Parmentier. This spring, Keith Raddatz, painting conservator, was enlisted to conserve the painting by flattening the canvas, repairing the tacking margin, and providing a light surface cleaning. The process returned a freshness to the canvas, most notably by improving the color of the skin tones and flowers. To complement the restoration of Elsbeth's portrait, the Pabst Mansion Volunteer Council sponsored her reframing. In June, the painting was returned to its original location for all to enjoy.

COL. PABST ALL-MALT AMBER LAGER

Worcestershire

Pabst family descendant Kate Quartaro (Gustave Pabst's great granddaughter and Frederick Pabst's great great granddaughter) has put her many skills to use in creating

Col. Pabst All-Malt Amber Lager Worcestershire

Kate was inspired by her family history and her love of cooking as told in her own words...

"My mom and grandfather always had fun cooking with beer. They put it in everything. I remember my mom making a Worcestershire sauce with beer once a long time ago (when I was a kid). ... I inherited the love of cooking with beer, so I decided to try making it ... it was very good, so I gave it out as Christmas gifts ... I decided to use Colonel Pabst (my mom's grandfather, whom she lived with for much of her childhood) for the brand name and logo.

I then attended classes at the Seibel Institute of Brewing in Chicago to learn more about the flavors of craft beers and how to pair them with different foods, etc. When I came back, I revised the recipe, and decided on an all-malt lager, which when cooked, lends itself to a beef flavor. I contacted Russ Klisch at Lakefront Brewery and he was great. He told me I could use Lakefront's w All-Malt Amber Lager Stein ... With the stein, the sauce is even better than when I first tried

It is rich, it is delicious, and it is available in the Pabst Mansion's gift shop.
